In History, we will be learning about Ipswich in the past. Focusing on some significant events and people in Ipswich's past and how it compares to now.








In Maths we will be focusing on addition and subtraction.

In DT we will be using our scientific knowledge to help us waterproof a hat.





Jesus is God's son. He told parables to teach about God


Everyone is welcome into the Christian family.
