HOMEWORK

Each Monday the children in hedgehogs will receive homework to complete for the following Monday. Homework will include:

- 10 Spellings 8 of these will have a particular spelling pattern, 2 of these will be from the year 3 and 4 spelling list. The children are always set their weekly spellings on spelling shed.
- 5 reads The children are encouraged to record their own reads in their log books. To get a sticker on the reading challenge chart, the log book page will need to be signed by a parent.
- English or Maths homework Each week
 the children will either receive an English focused
 piece of work which could be grammar or
 guided reading, or a maths focused piece of
 work.
- **Times tables** There is a huge focus on times tables in year 3 and 4. The children are all signed up tor times table rock stars to help with this.
