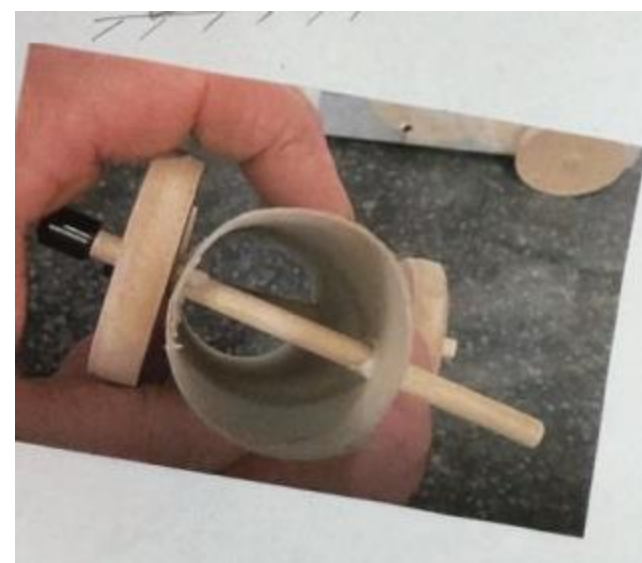
In Writing, we will be learning how to write instructions and informal letters.

In Geography we will be revisiting our knowledge of human and physical features and map skills to create maps of Mersea Island.

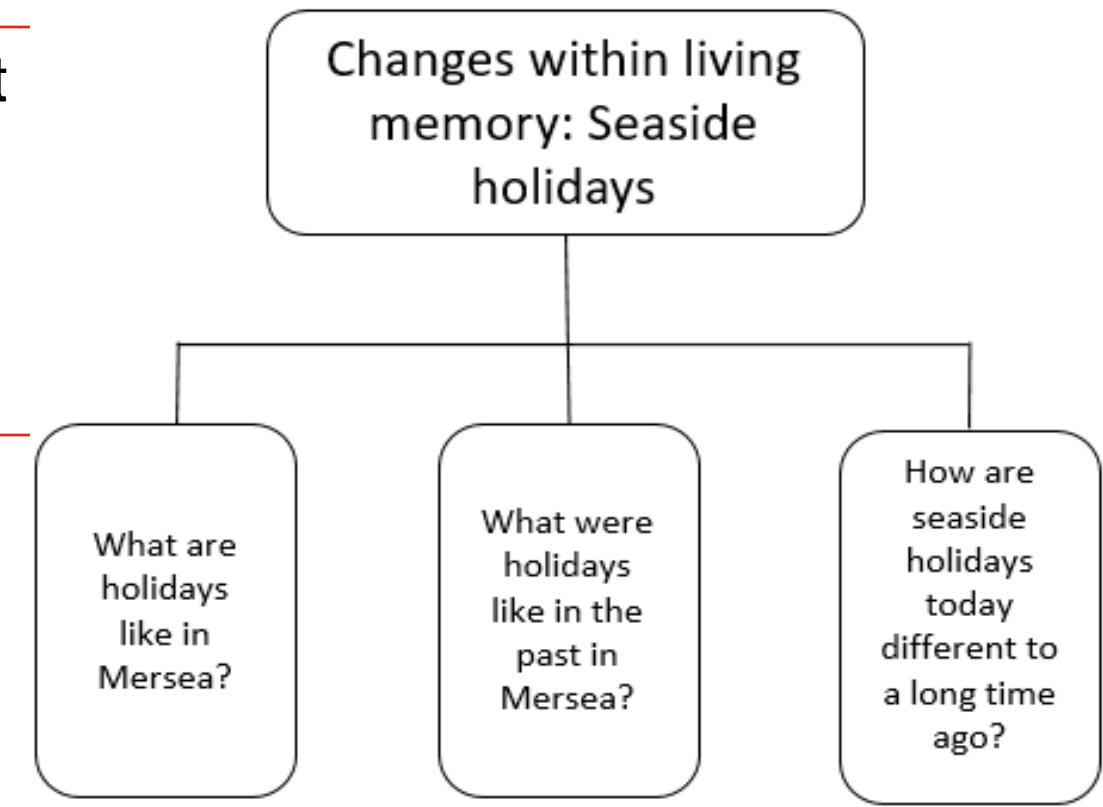
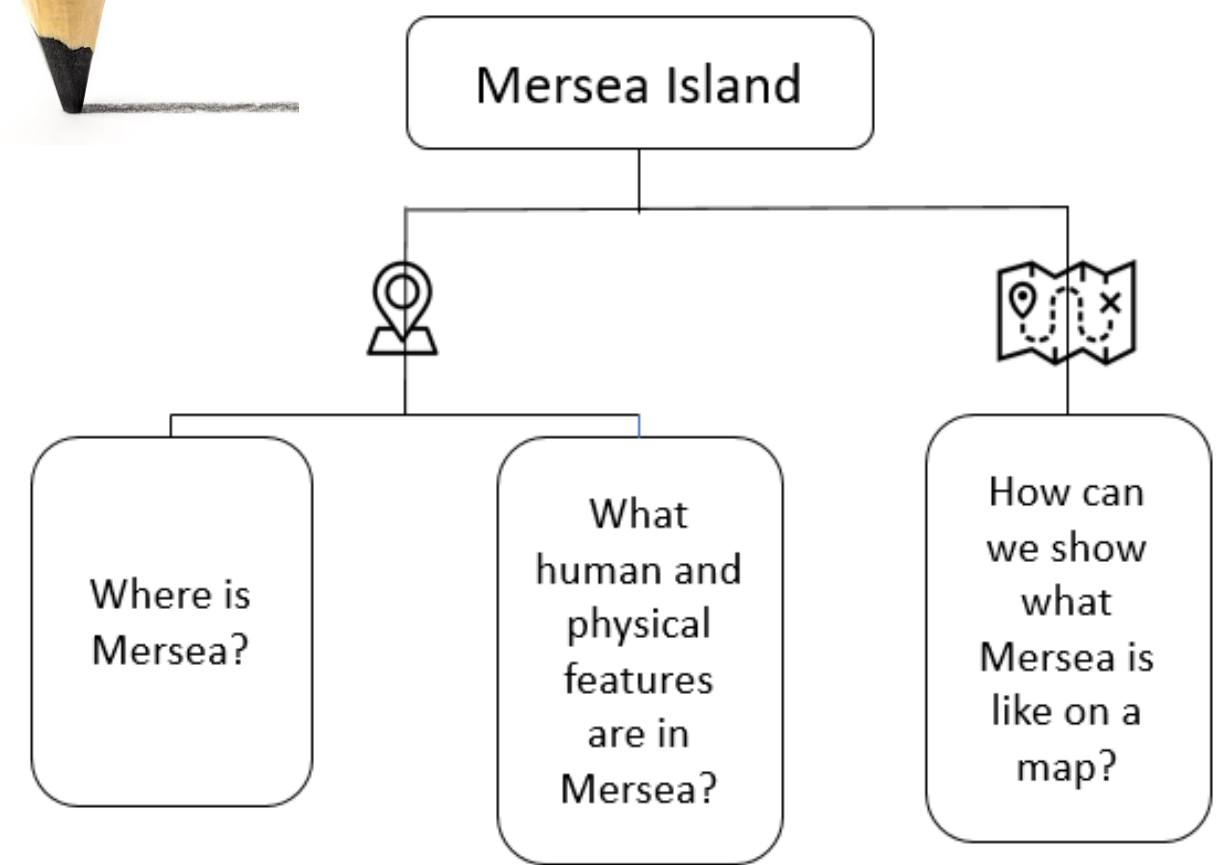


In History we will be learning about how seaside holidays have changed in living memory. We will be visiting Mersea Island to enhance our learning.

Y1/2 Curriculum map Summer 2

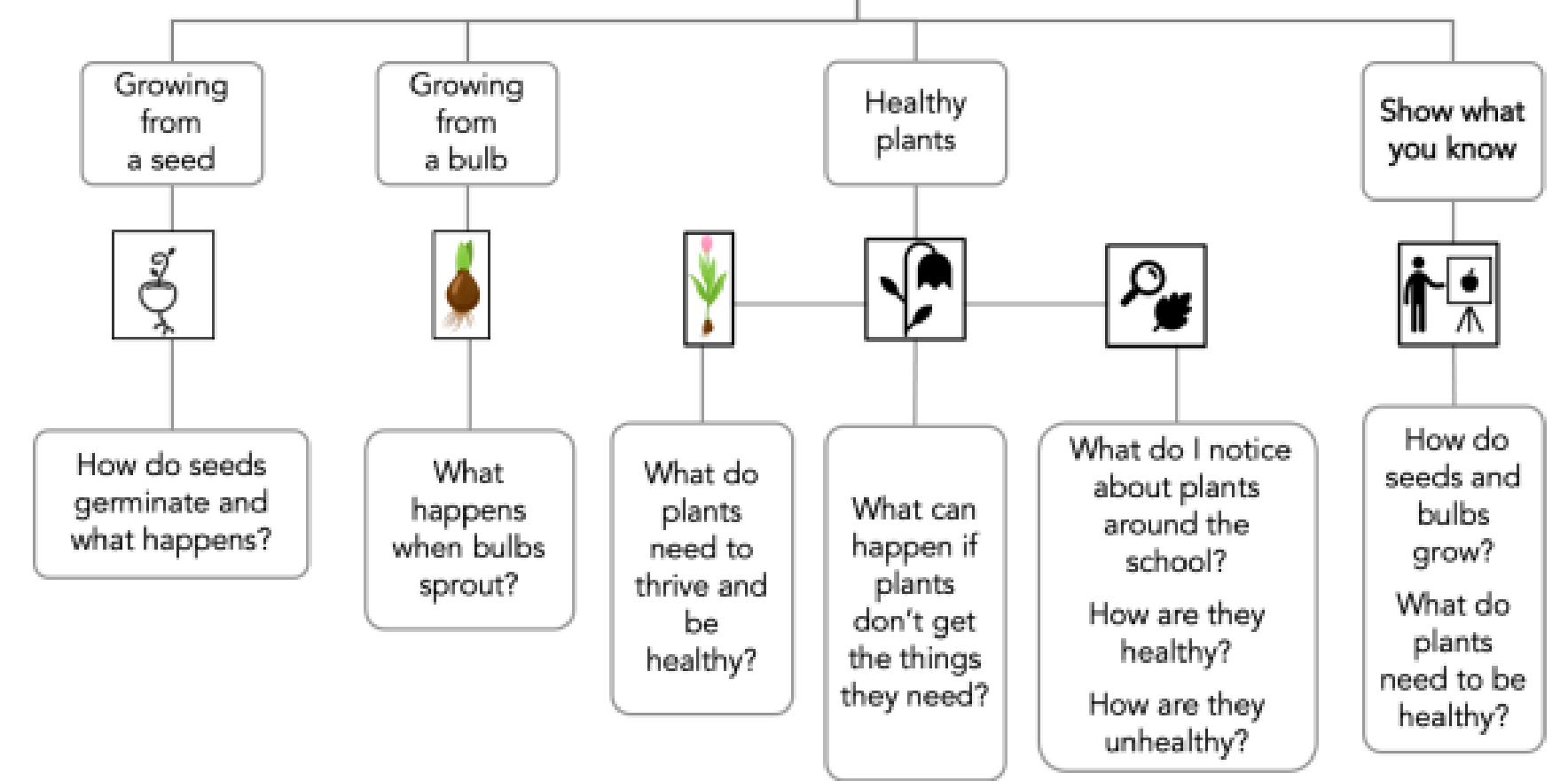

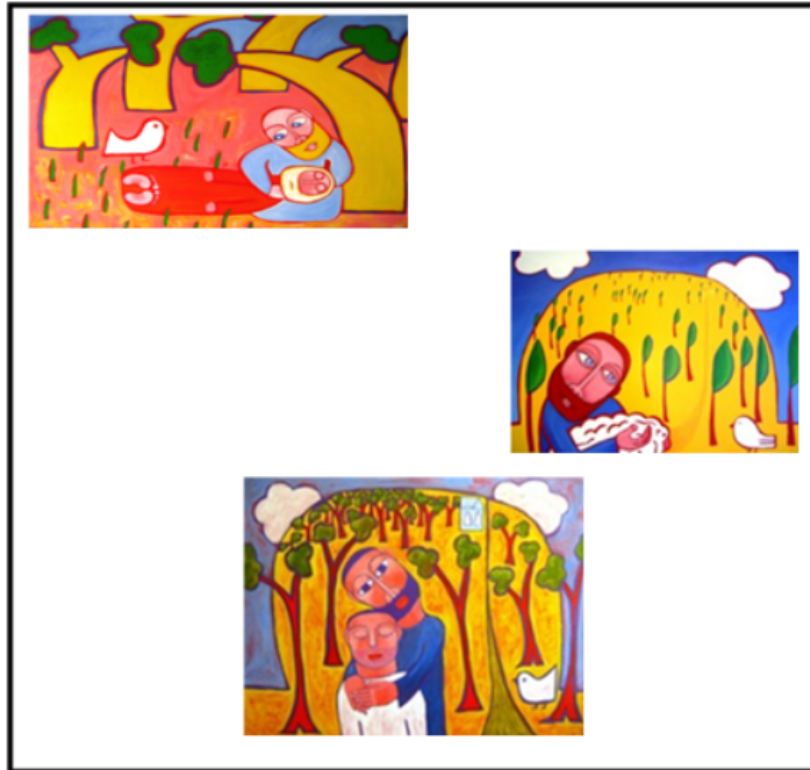

KS1 What did Jesus teach about God in his parables?

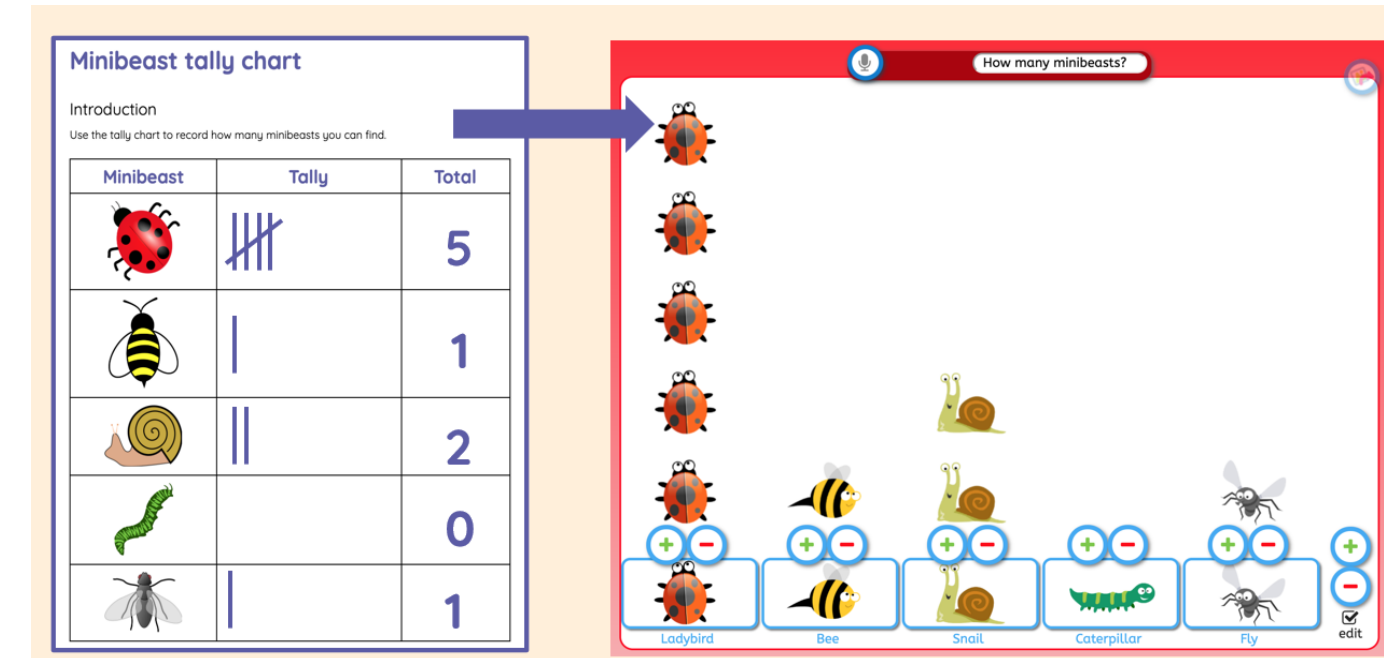
Prior learning Christians believe:
 God is a VIP and Jesus, his son, was a very special baby.
 Jesus died on a cross.
 Everyone, and our world, is precious to God.
 Babies are **welcomed** into the Christian family.

What should we know?
 A **parable** is a story with a special meaning.
 The parables of Jesus are found in the Bible.
 Christians believe:

- Jesus used parables to help his followers learn about God.
- Christians retell the parables in different ways.
- Christians hope that the good news about God loving and caring for people will help everyone know they are precious to God.



What should we be able to do?
 Recognise one of the parables of Jesus.
 Retell parts of a parable.
 Know who these parables are special to.
