

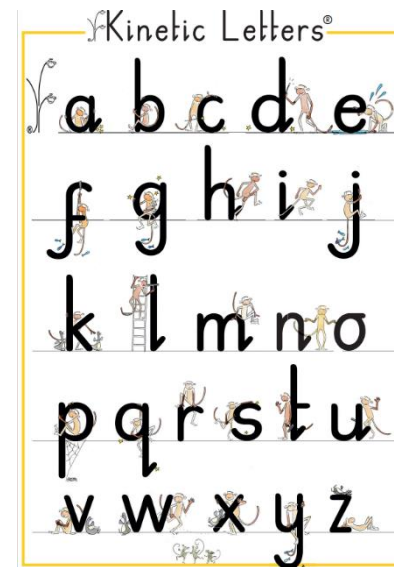


We will be reading and exploring the following books

Followers	A person who believes in, studies, or supports the ideas of a teacher or other leader.
