Important roadworks information A14 junctions 51 to 50 – Tree removal and replanting

I'm writing to inform you that we will be carrying out essential work on the A14 between junctions 51 and 50 which will involve cutting down and removing diseased trees suffering from Ash Die Back. As part of this work, we will also be replanting with a mixture of new species.

This work is part of a wider project on the A14 between junctions 58 and 49. We will communicate further details of additional phases in due course.

This phase will be carried out over **seven nights** from **Thursday 23 January.** We will work between **8pm** and **6am** on weeknights only, weather permitting.

Closures and diversions

To carry out the work safely, we will need to close the A14 westbound and divert traffic as detailed below:

Closure	Date	Diversion
A14 junction 51 to 50 westbound- full closure	Thursday 23 January, 8pm to Wednesday 29 January, 6am	Traffic will be diverted off the A14 at junction 51 via the A140 and A1120, rejoining the A14 westbound at junction 50. (Map 1)
A14 junction 50 westbound entry slip	Wednesday 29 January, 8pm to Saturday 1 February, 6am	Traffic will be diverted onto the A14 eastbound to junction 51, then return westbound. (Map 2)




