narrow	Not wide or broad.

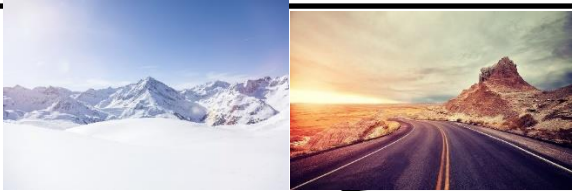


In Maths we will continue to develop our subitising and counting skills and explore the composition of numbers within and beyond 5. We will begin to identify when two sets are equal or unequal and connect two equal groups to doubles.

This half term we will continue our focus on writing captions, labels and simple sentences. We will be practicing our segmenting and blending skills to help with sounding out words.
