## National Curriculum Objectives:

## Differentiation:

Developing Questions to support adding the suffixes -ful, -less. Includes words where no changes to the spelling are required. For example: play + ful = playful, help + ful = helpful, care + less = careless.
Expected Questions to support adding the suffixes -ful, -less. Includes some common exception words where the root word may/may not need changing. (For example: plenty + ful = plentiful, joy + ful = joyful, penny + less = penniless).
Greater Depth Questions to support adding the suffixes -ful, -less. Includes words where the meaning is less explicit, and the root word may/may not need to change. (For example:
pity $+\mathrm{ful}=$ pitiful, spite $+\mathrm{ful}=$ spiteful).
