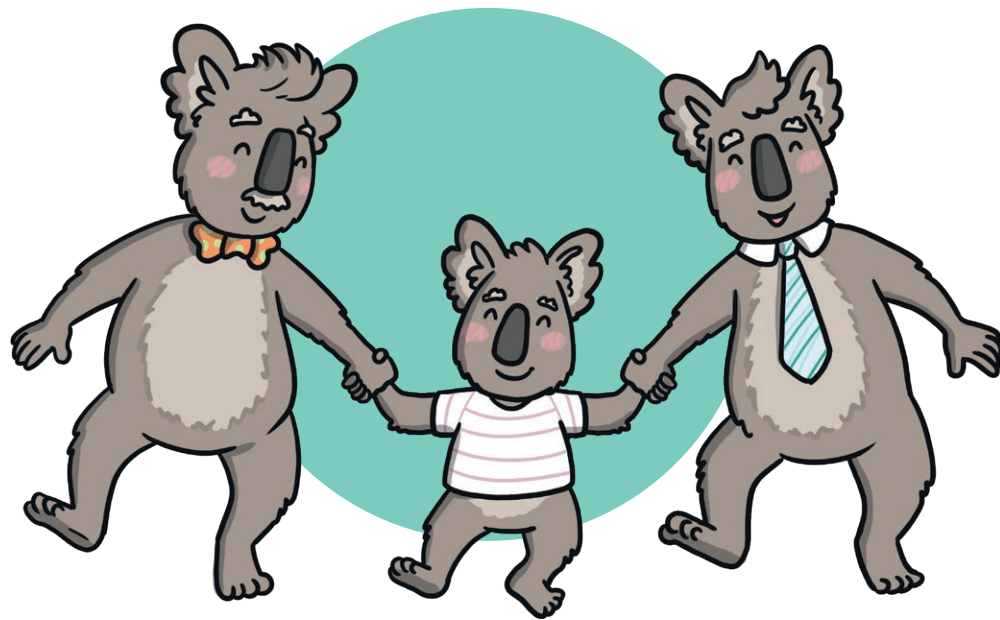

One Saturday morning, as Dad was playing air guitar, Karri was surprised to see that the delivery bird had brought a special leaflet.



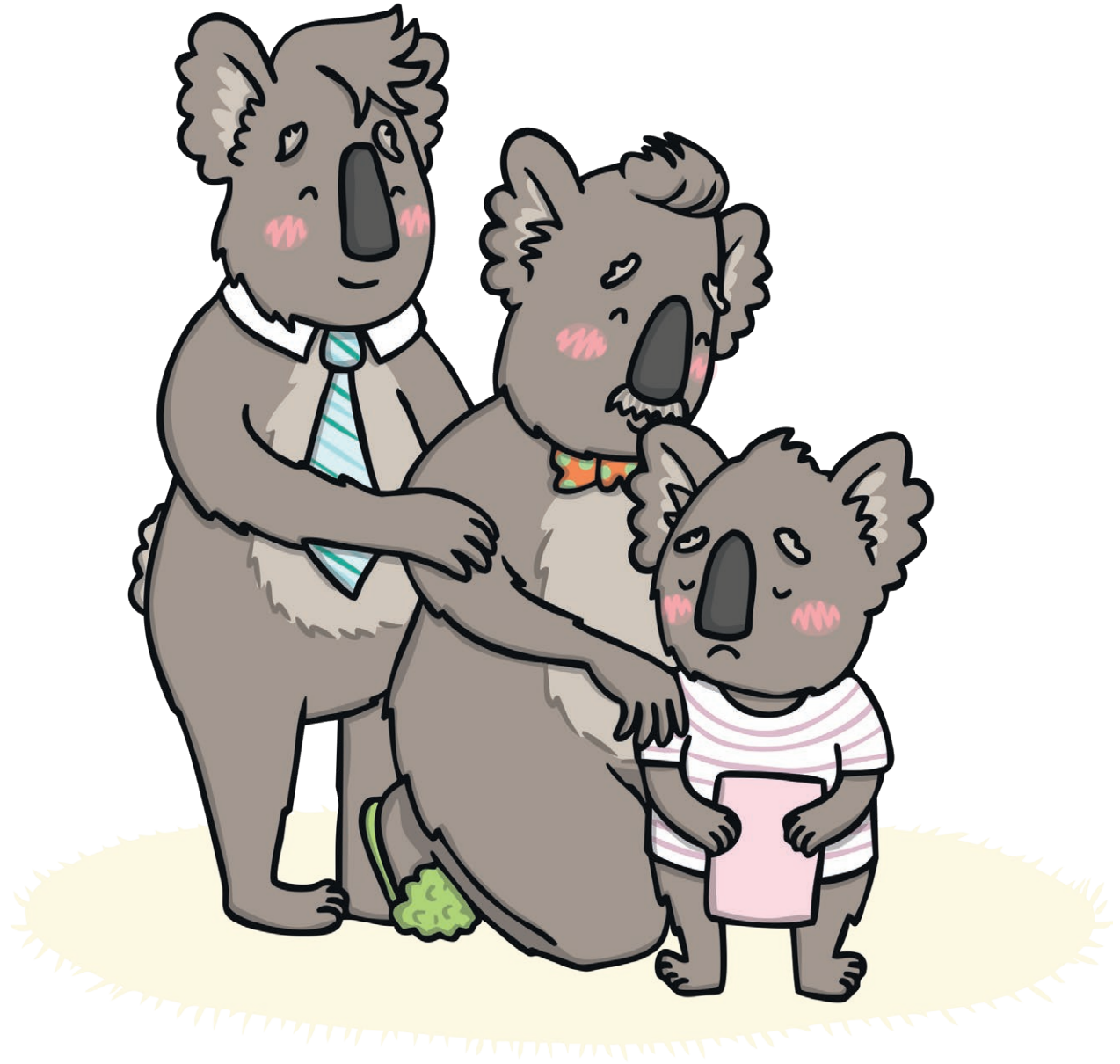
Karri ran inside, excited to tell her dads that there was going to be a disco in town!

Karri's smile faded as she read the words out loud.

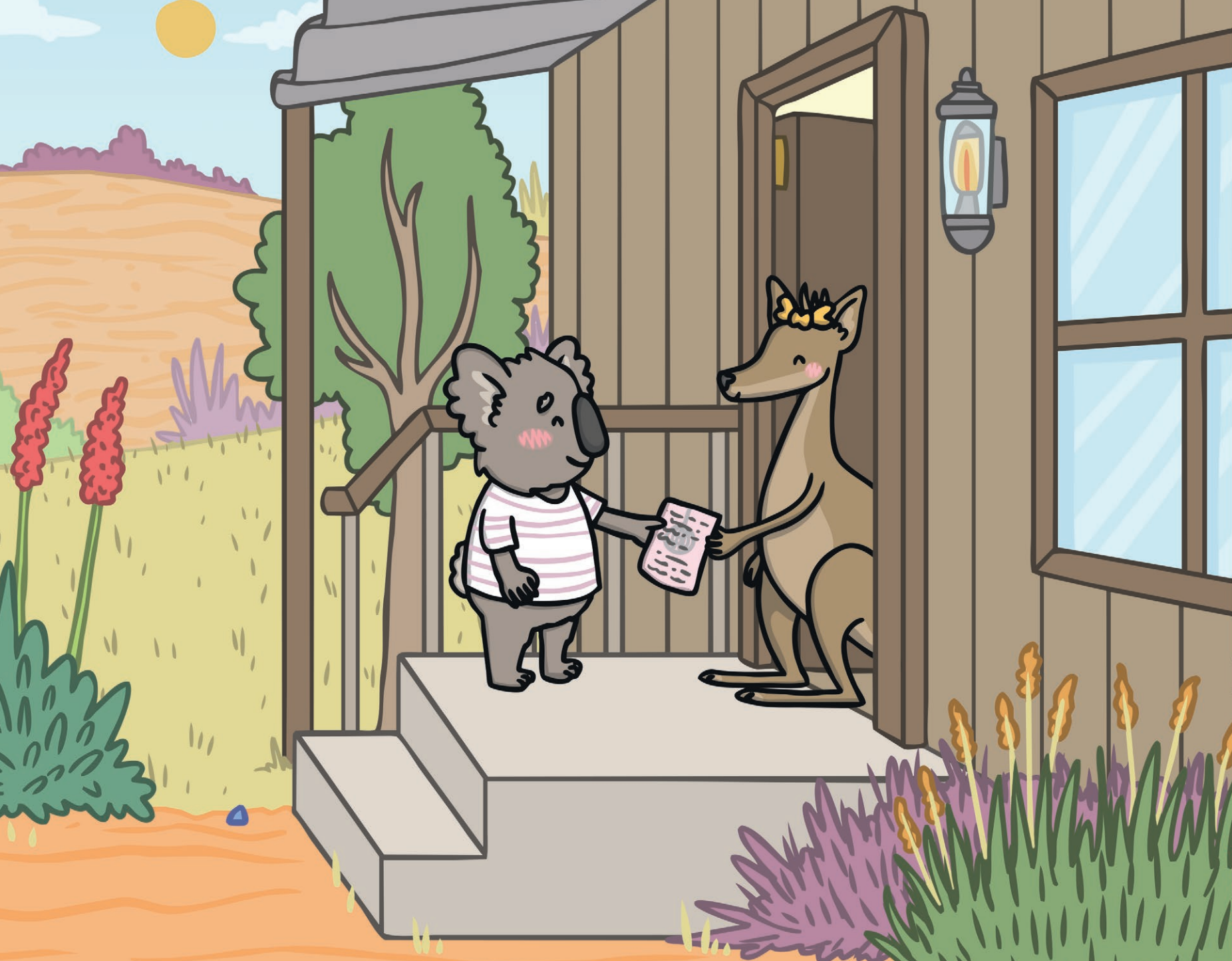


"But I don't have a mummy in my family," she said.

“I definitely want to go,” said Katy, excitedly.



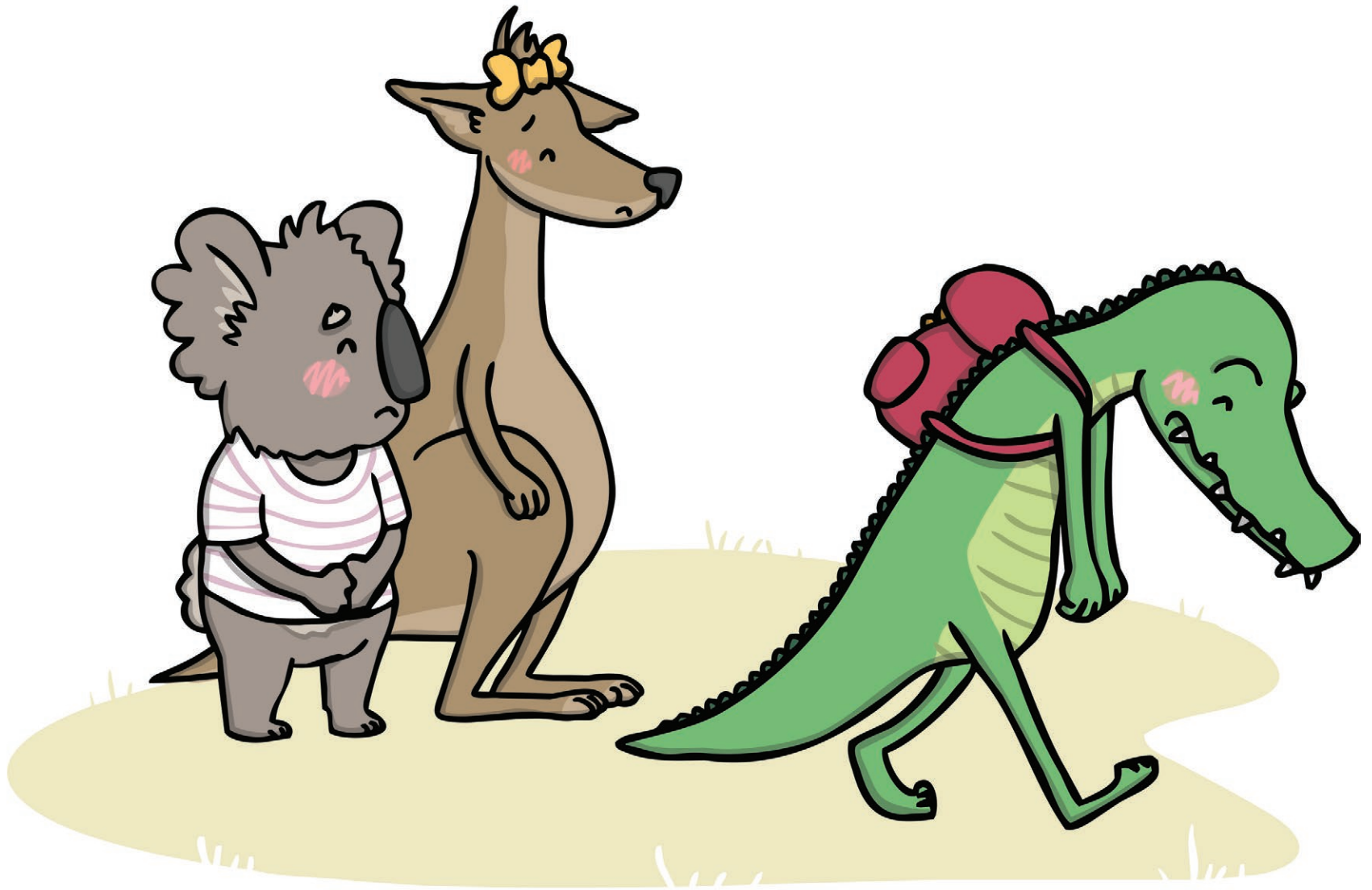
“My gran has some amazing dance moves.

and she walked away sadly.



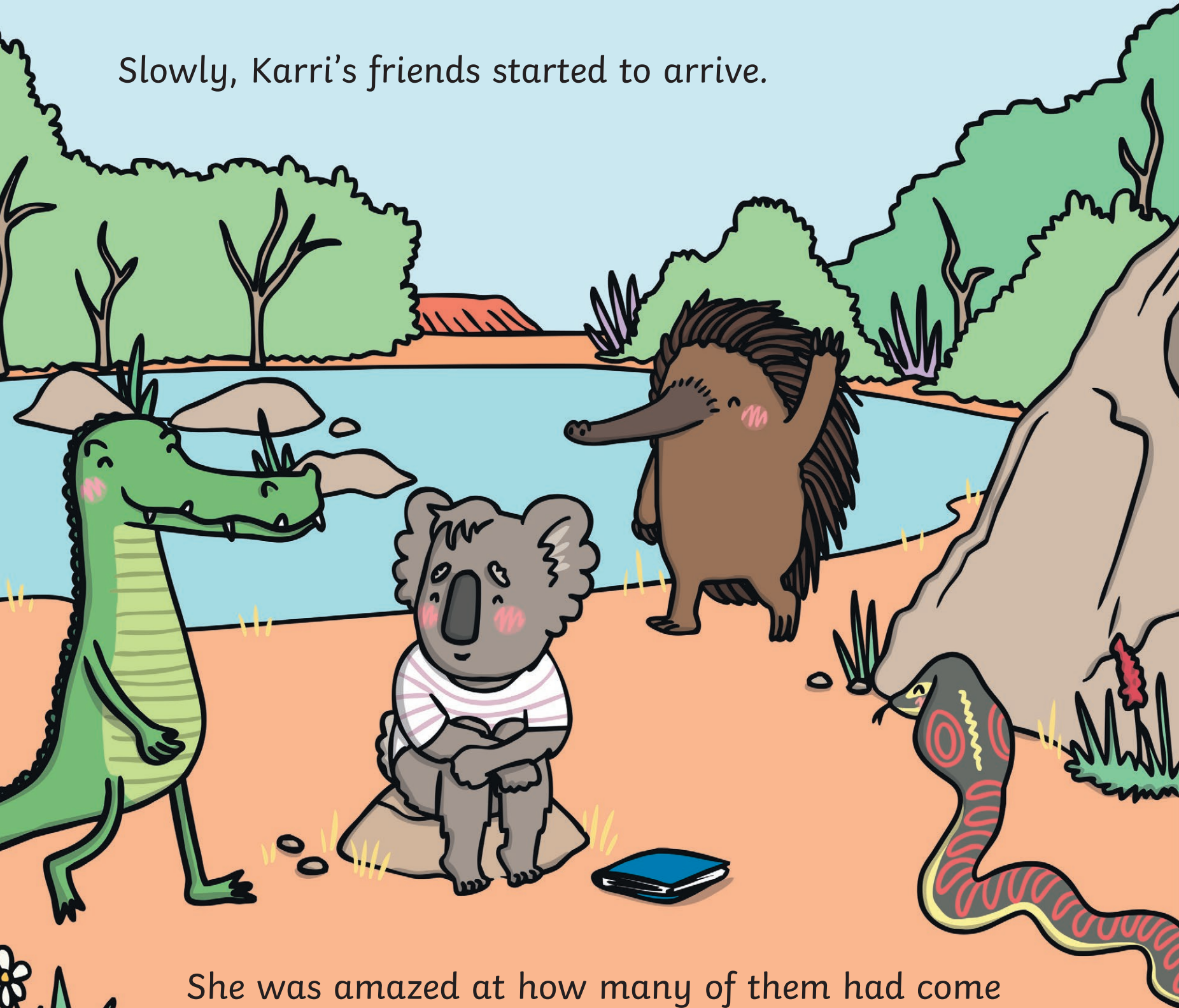

She told Dad what had happened at the meeting.

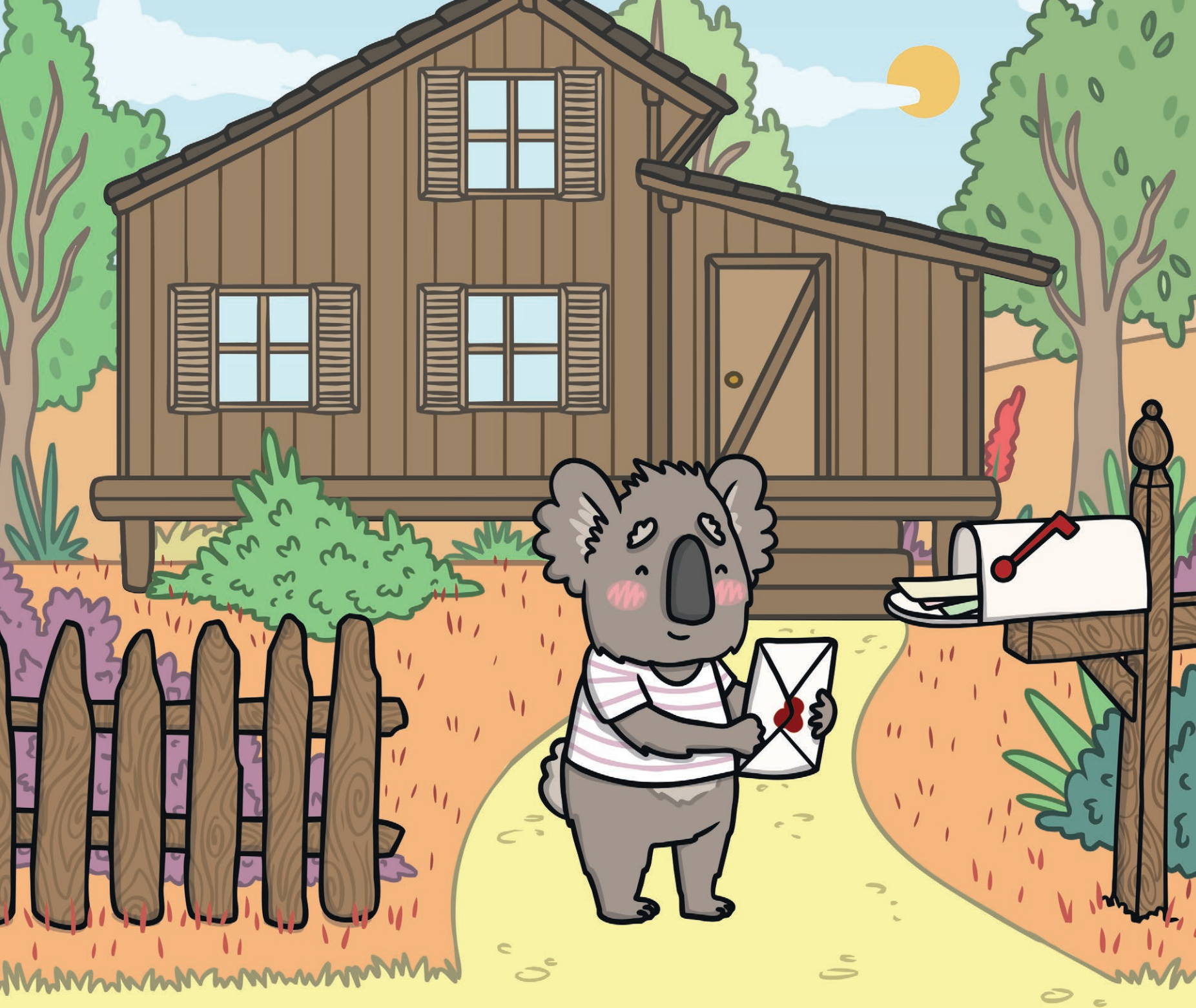


“Why don’t you write a letter to the mayor?” suggested Dad.

Karri sat down and wrote a letter, telling the mayor about all of the different families who would not be included at his disco.

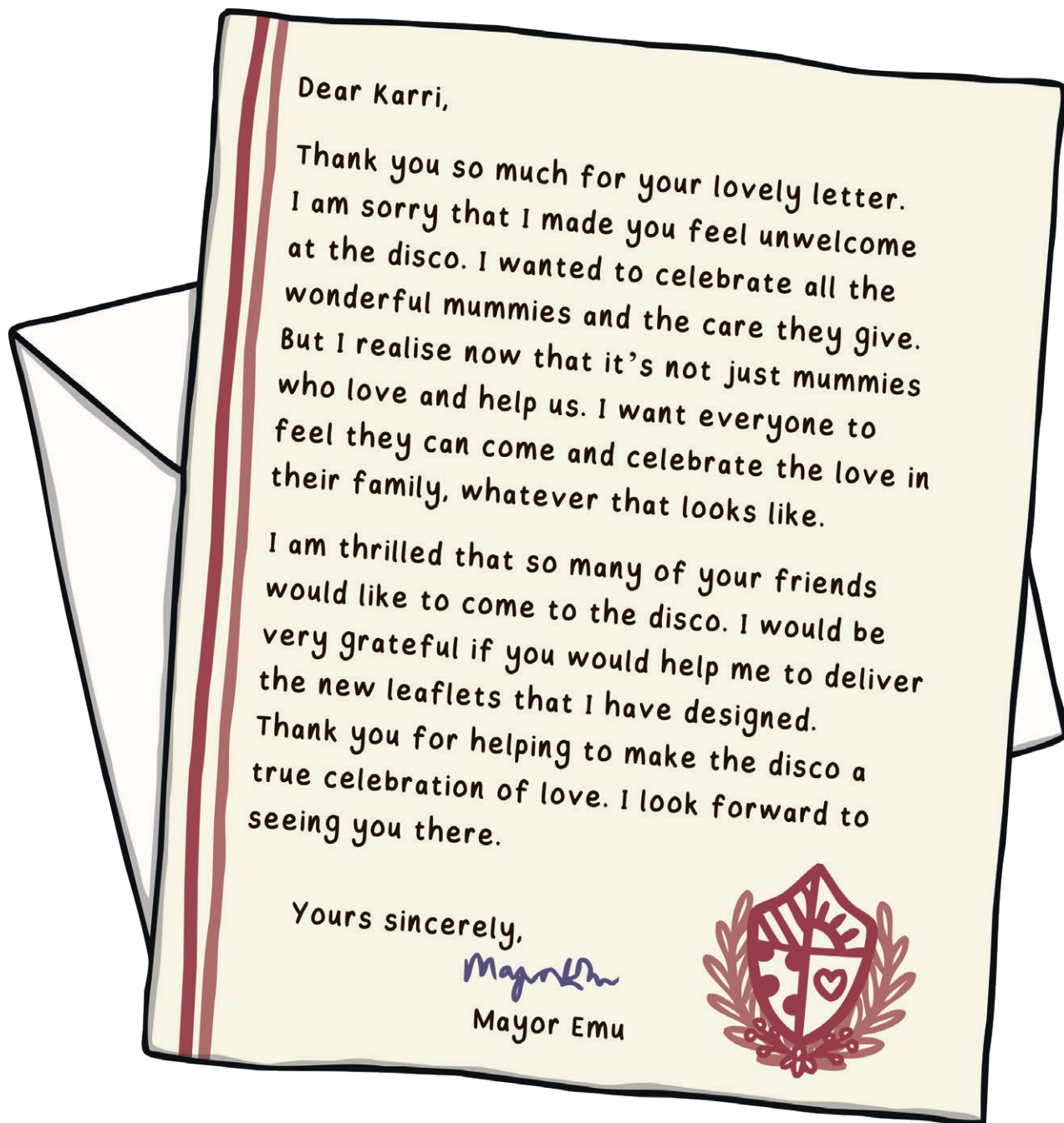


She posted the letter and waited.

“This is the best disco ever,” she said, “and the best part of all is having you both here to share it with me!”

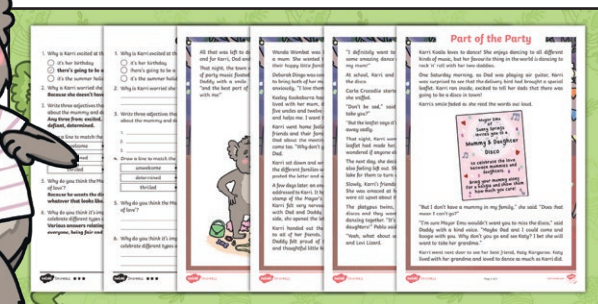
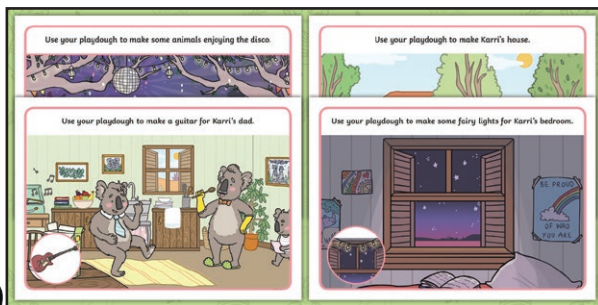
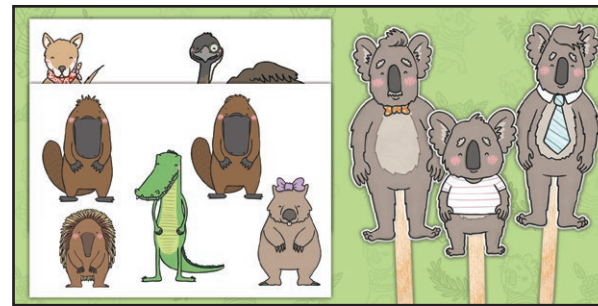
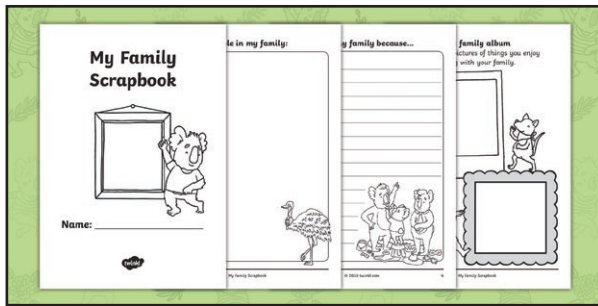
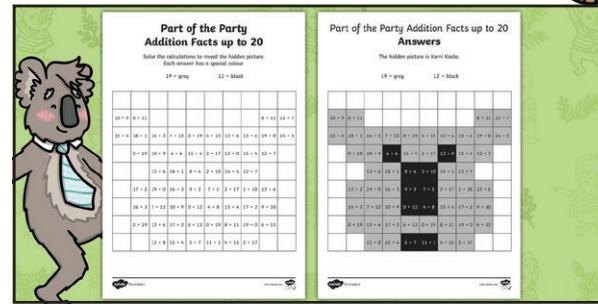
