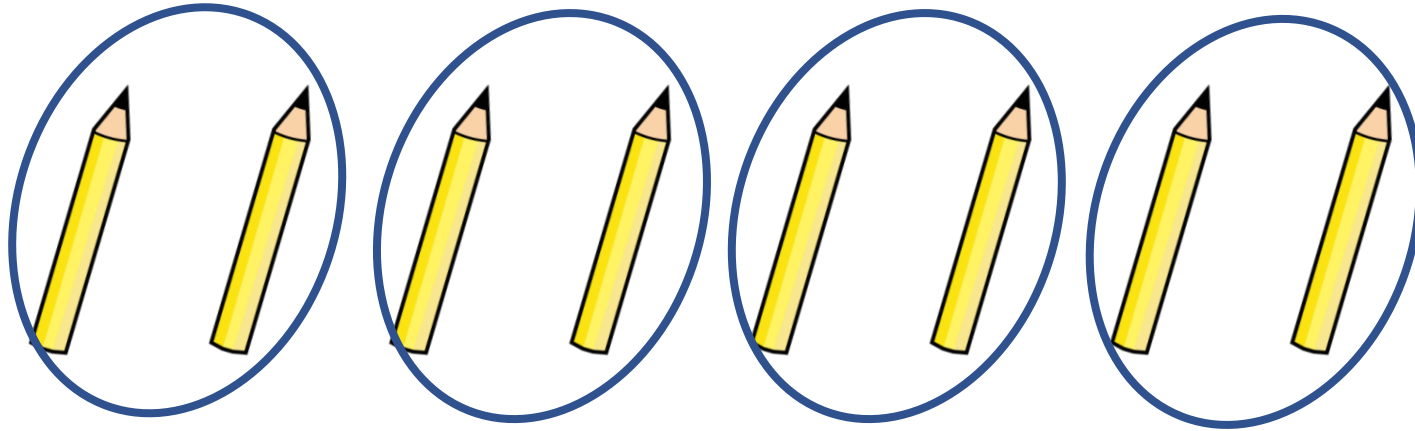

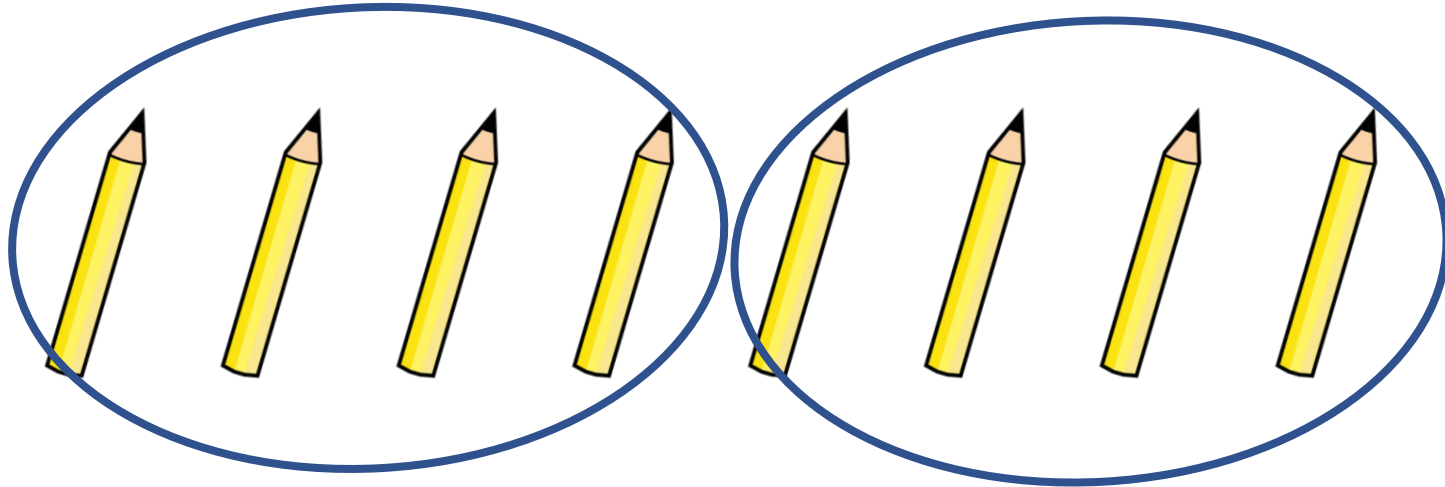


There are **8** pencils altogether.

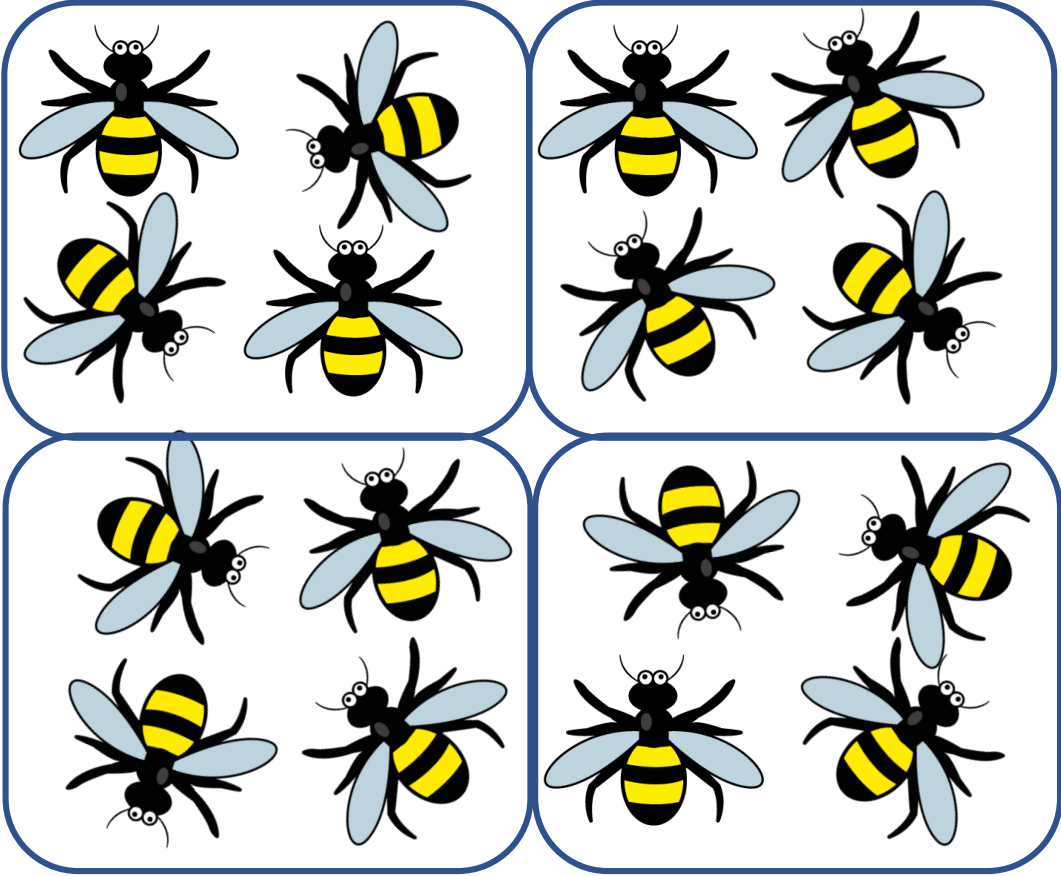

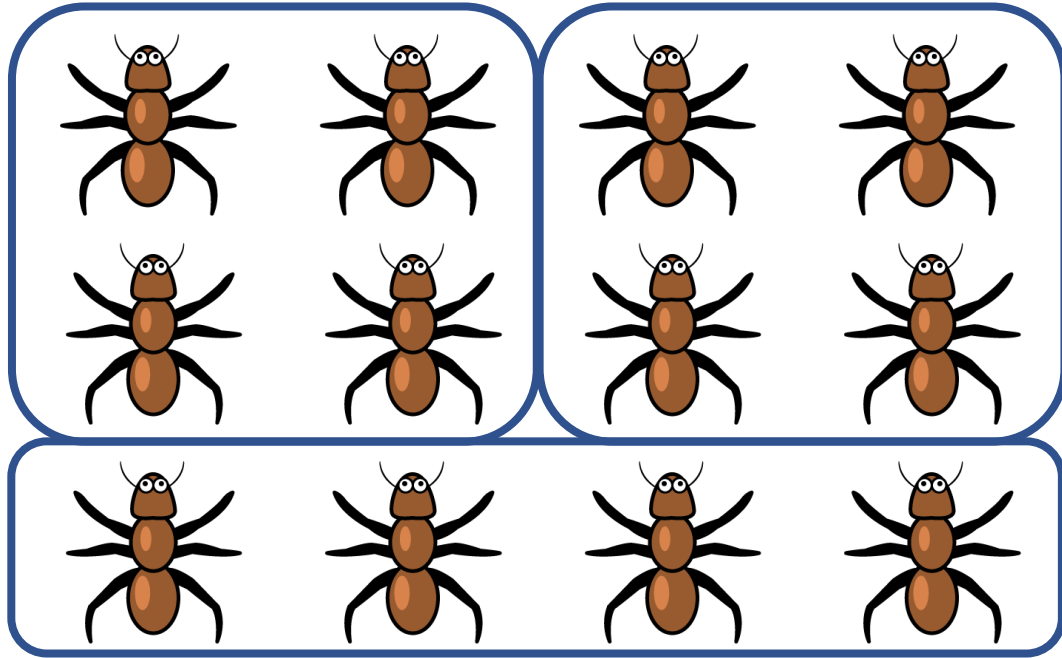

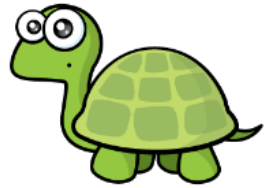

This looks like an array!

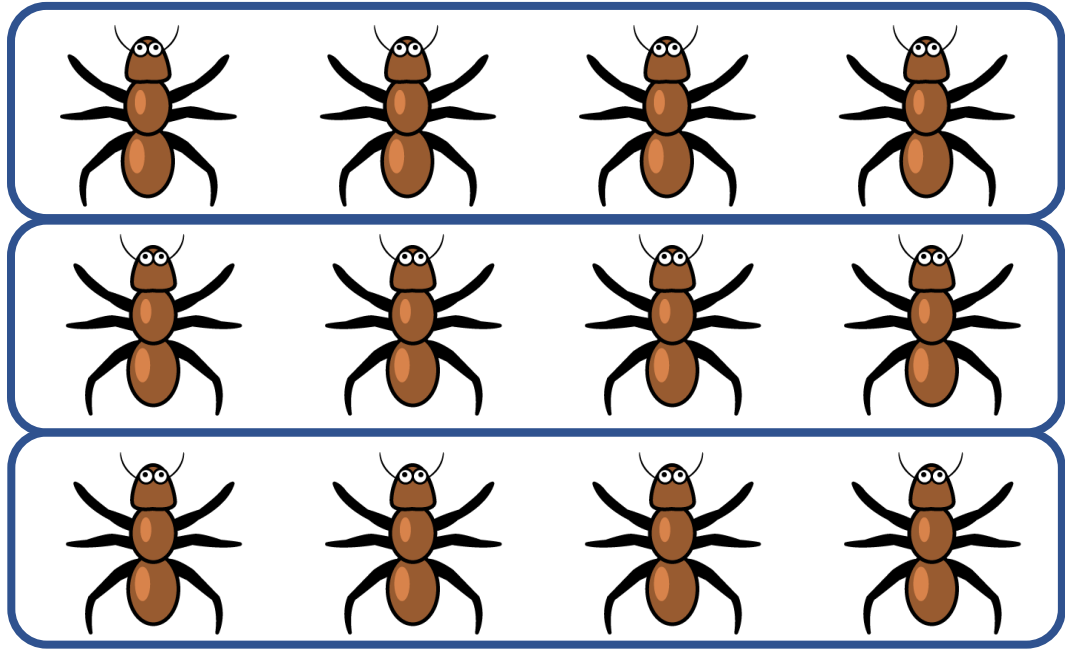

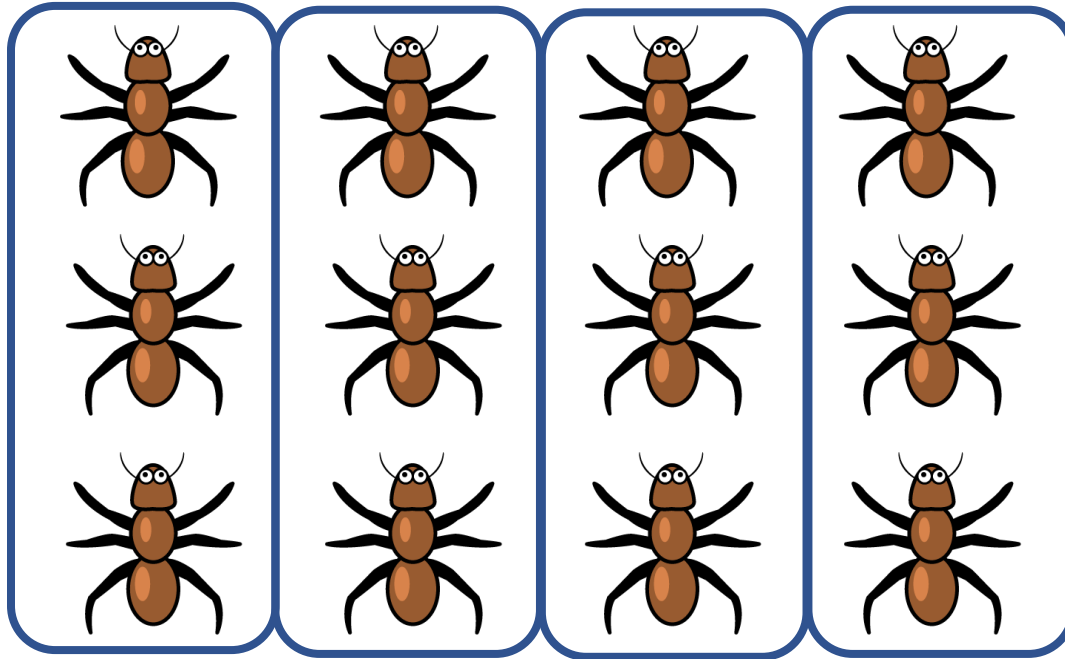
This looks like an array!

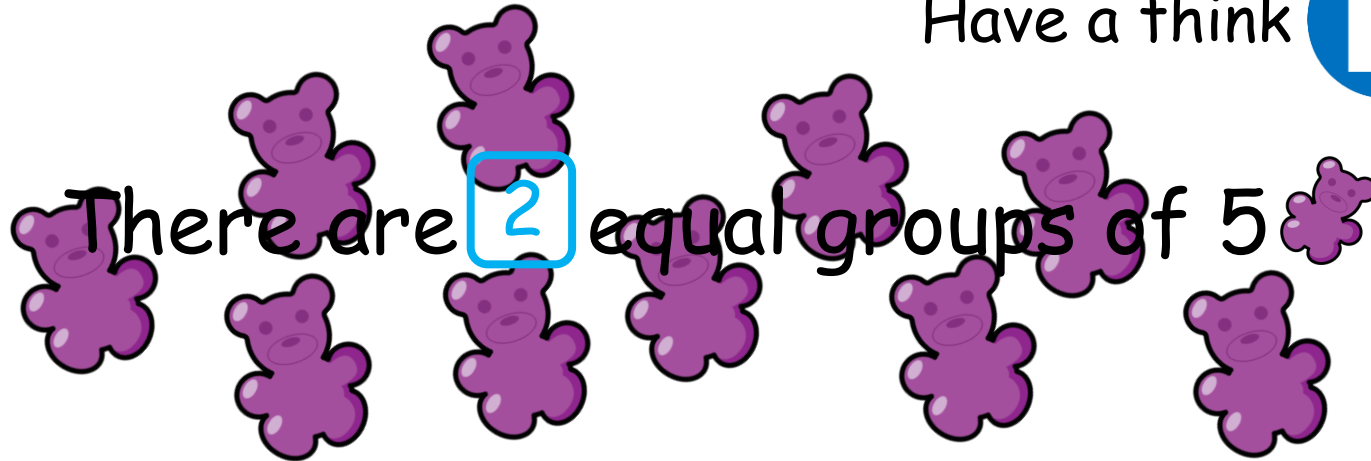
