keep safe.

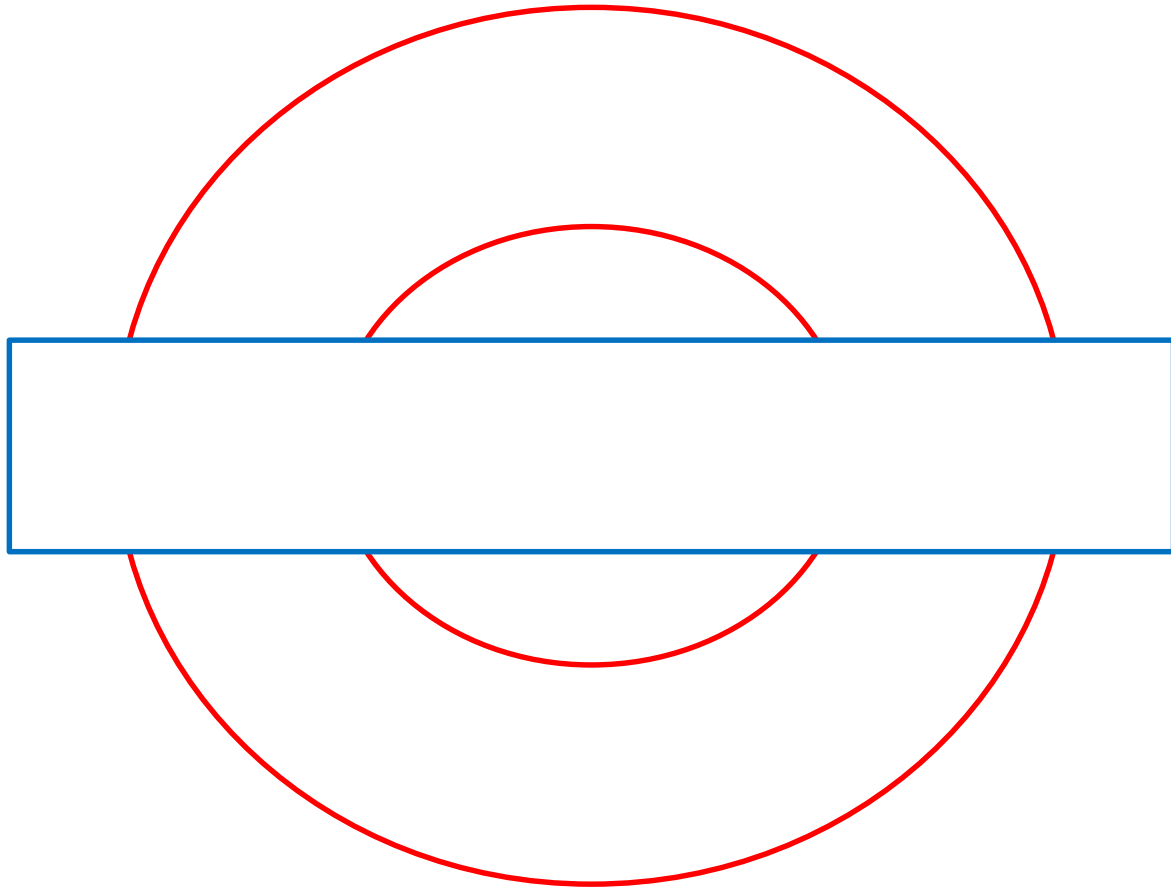


The London Underground
