Dear Parents,

We have been discussing the best way to share an update on your child's learning behaviour and progress since returning to school. Whilst we value the face to face meetings and open learning sessions we usually hold in the autumn term, we have accepted that in the current climate this is not advisable for the safety of our whole school community.

Teachers will shortly be writing a report to be included in your child's Learning Journey record. These reports will be uploaded to your child's page of the website as in the summer term. The report will share information about your child's personal skills, English and Maths and will provide some feedback on next step targets and how you can continue to support them at home. Each child will also be completing a reflection, sharing their views on settling back into learning and the skills they feel they have further developed.

Reports will be added to the website on Friday 6th November and there will be an opportunity for you to request a phone call or video chat to discuss this further, should you so wish. Staff will be available at set times throughout the week commencing 16th November to answer any questions you may have once you have read your child's report. We will be sending out an online form for completion, to confirm you have received your child's report and enable you to make a comment. This form will also provide an opportunity for you to sign up for a call with the teacher if you would like one.

We hope this enables us to continue our partnership working despite the challenging circumstances.
