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Spellings	Introduction	To turn -ible and -able adjectives into adverbs, we replace the -le ending of the adjective with -ly
reversibly	Main Teaching Activity	Get the children to reverse the rule by turning the adverb back in to an adjective by removing 'ly' and adding 'le'.  Share the adjectives and discuss any misunderstandings.

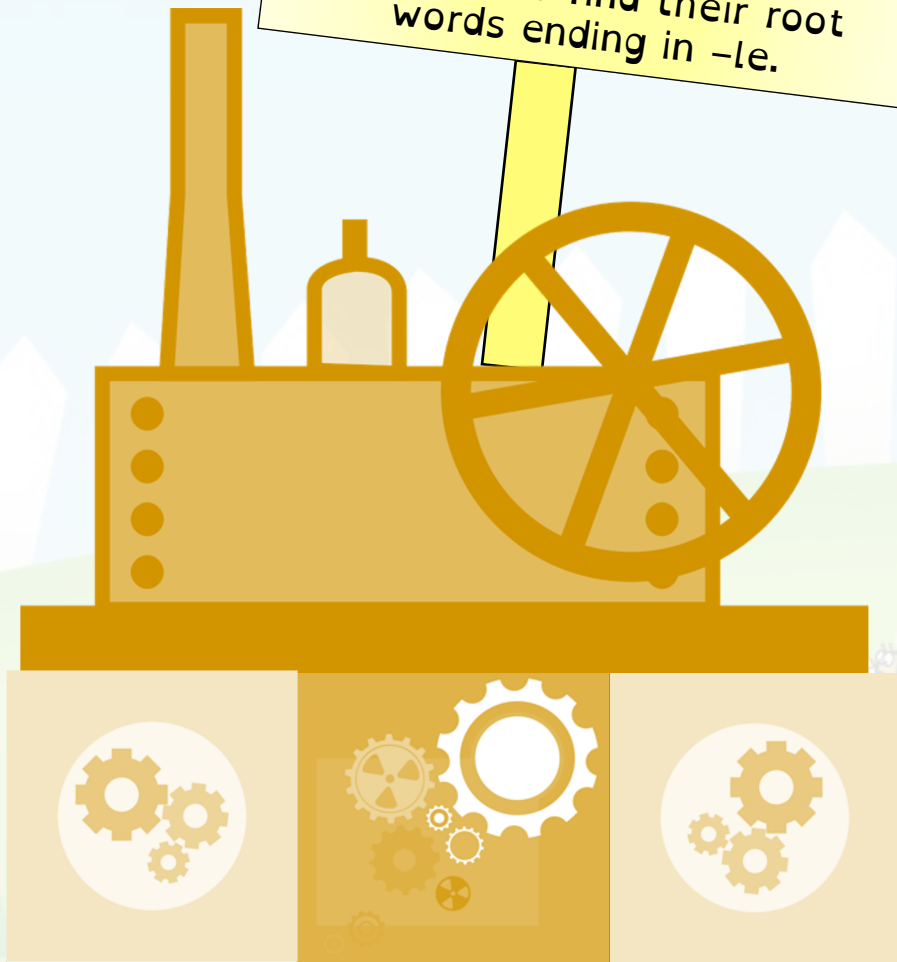
